

## **Manifold Online Support for Jordanian Exporters**

JORDAN EXPORTS (JE) is providing a wide range of information on accessing export markets much of which is channeled through the **Jordan Export Portal (JEP)**: <https://jordanexportportal.gov.jo/>. Institutions from target countries themselves are also providing useful information to enter their markets. For this, exporters can tap into various online tools to facilitate imports into these markets.

Here are some examples:

**Exporting Dates to the European Union:** Click on <https://trade.ec.europa.eu/access-to-markets/en/home> and enter “dates” in the field *product name* under *Goods + ROSA*, “Jordan” into *Export Country* and, e.g., “France” into *Destination Country* and click *Search*. You will be shown several options to further clarify your choice and its respective HS code. You may continue with the option “Dates, fresh or dried, for use in the manufacture (excluding packing) of products of drink or food industries” 08 04 10 00 30. Detailed information about the applicable tariffs, Rules of Origin, import requirements, taxes, and trade statistics (Jordanian export values of dates to France and to the EU27), as well as further explanations appear.

**Exporting Olive Oil to the UK:** Click on <https://www.gov.uk/get-rules-tariffs-trade-with-uk> click on *Start now >* / enter “Olive Oil” into *Search the UK Integrated Online Tariff*. Click on a commodity (code). Enter “Jordan” into *Select Country*. Detailed information about the trade status, tariffs, and taxes, other measures, rules of origin, and product-specific regulations (with variations for Northern Ireland) will show up.

**Exporting to the US:** Please find guides from our partner AmCham Jordan on exporting goods and on exporting services to the U.S. here: <https://amcham.jo/guides/>. They are deploying a specific Jordan-US FTA-Unit (<https://amcham.jo/jordan-u-s-fta-unit/>).

Other online sources to find out about certain tariffs and regulations are, e.g., <https://www.cbp.gov/trade/programs-administration/determining-duty-rates> (from the US Customs and Border Protection) and <https://dataweb.usitc.gov/> (US International Trade Commission) where you can use an HTS Search or check for other information.

Further examples:

- Exporting **to Canada**; this is limited to FTAs, but Jordan has one with Canada (<https://www.tariffinder.ca/en/>).
- Exports **to Japan**; with information to a certain extent (<https://www.customs.go.jp/english/tariff/index.htm>).
- Data from the WTO on a wide range of markets (<https://ttd.wto.org/en>).
